Not being able to come to school because of the snow is really exciting. Choose from any of the activities below and give to your teacher when you return or ask an adult to email any photographs.

ENGLISH

- Write an imaginative story about a snowman that comes to life in your garden.
- Write a diary of what you have done in the snow.
- Write a set of instructions on how to build a snowman/snow sculpture.
- List as many adjectives as you can to describe the snow and the weather. Can you use your adjectives to make your own wordsearch?
- Write and illustrate a poem about the snow – this could be an acrostic, shape, haiku or kenning poem.
- Continue to read your home reading book or reading passport and practise any spellings.

MATHS

- Design a snowman made out of 2D shapes – can you make it symmetrical?
- Log on to 'Complete Maths Tutor' and / Times Table Rockstars.
- Make the tallest snow sculpture you can and measure it. Take a photo, if possible!
- Make a 3D model from boxes and things you can find in your home – remember to take a photo and put things back when finished.

ART & DESIGN

- Look out of a window at home and draw exactly what you can see.
- Make a 'snow day' collage.
- Make a detailed sketch, drawing or painting of your favourite toy.
- Design and label your own 'super sledge'. List the materials you would need to build it.
- Design your own 'snow' board game. Remember to write the rules.

SCIENCE

- Investigate snow and ice, e.g. how long does it take to melt in different places inside and outside your house? Which footwear is better to wear outside when it is snowy and icy?

PSHE

- Design your own healthy menu for either breakfast, lunch or dinner. What ingredients will you need and what are the instructions for the recipe?
- Design a target to throw snowballs at – remember to take a photo!
